

## FAQs

*What time will the school day begin and end?*

The Intermediate School will follow the same schedule as the elementary school. Class will begin in the morning at 8:20 am and end at 3:30 pm.

*Who will my child share a bus with?*

Intermediate students will be riding the bus with elementary students to and from school.

*Where will my child eat lunch and have recess?*

Intermediate students will eat together in the middle school commons and will have recess on the playground nearest the intermediate school. Consideration is being given to expand recess equipment, i.e. swings, climbing apparatus and basketball hoops.

*Does the multi-age concept apply to all academic subject areas?*

With the exception of math, all core academic and exploratory subjects will be multi-age.

*How will classroom sections be chosen?*

Class lists will be formed collaboratively by third and fourth grade teachers, school counselors and the administrative team with the goal of placing students in a learning environment where they can all be successful.

*What exploratory subjects will be offered to the intermediate students?*

All intermediate students will have Physical Education, Music, Art, Foreign Language and Keyboarding.

*Will my child have a locker in the intermediate school?*

The existing lockers will be removed from the hallway of the intermediate school. All students will have cubbies much like they have in the elementary school.

*Will there still be Title I, Special Education and Gifted and Talented Services for intermediate students?*

Students who are in need of these services will still be provided them in the intermediate school.
