Partnership Announced Athletic Complex Redevelopment Project

On February 20, 2017, the Altoona School Board adopted a Resolution allowing the District to proceed with a campaign to raise donations of not less than \$1,000,000 to support the Athletic Complex Redevelopment Project. Under the guidelines of the Resolution, the Board requires financial commitments of at least \$1,000,000 from outside sources before they proceed with a plan that will not increase property taxes.

In June of 2017, CCF Bank became our first partner with their donation of \$250,000 toward the project. Another significant commitment of \$50,000 was made by the Altoona Athletic Booster Club in November, 2017.

Now, on October 3, 2018, we're excited to announce that OakLeaf Hospital has joined the list of contributors with their donation of \$500,000 to the OakLeaf Stadium!
