Altoona High School joins the Middle Border Conference Schools which include Amery, Baldwin-Woodville, Ellsworth, New Richmond, Osceola, Prescott, Sain Croix Central, and Somerset. The Railroaders are already part of the MBC in boys' hockey and boys' tennis.
